
WEDNESDAY NIGHT DINNERS are \$6 for adults and \$3 for children. We start serving at 5:30pm in the fellowship hall.

If this is your first Sunday, it might be nice to know...


- We are glad you are here! We have gifts for first-time guests at the table in the back of the Sanctuary.
