Especially if this is your first Sunday, Welcome!

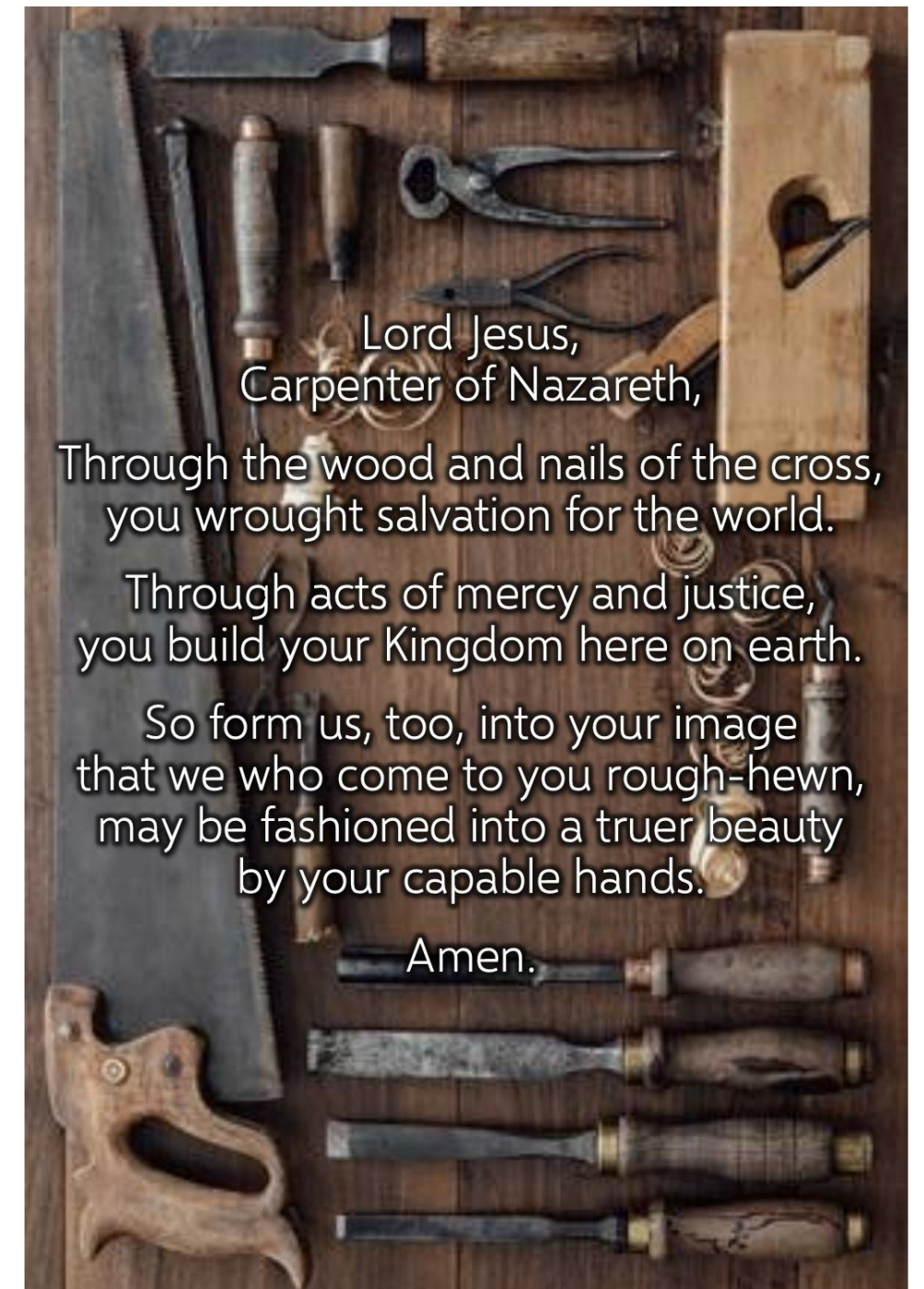
- We have gifts for first-time guests at the welcome table at the sanctuary entrance
