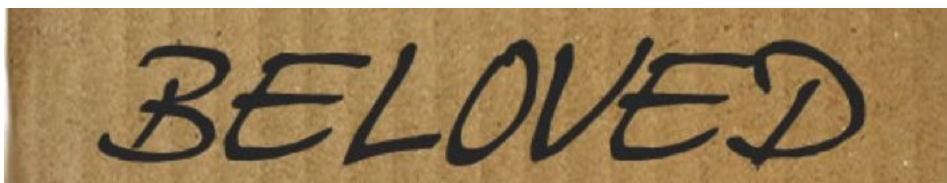

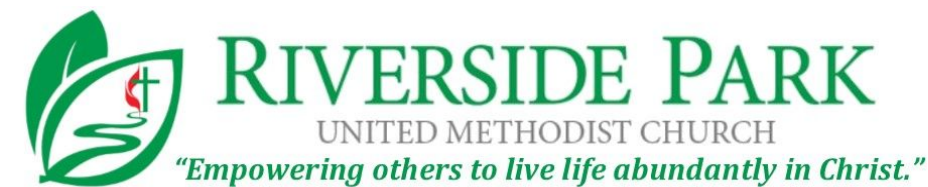

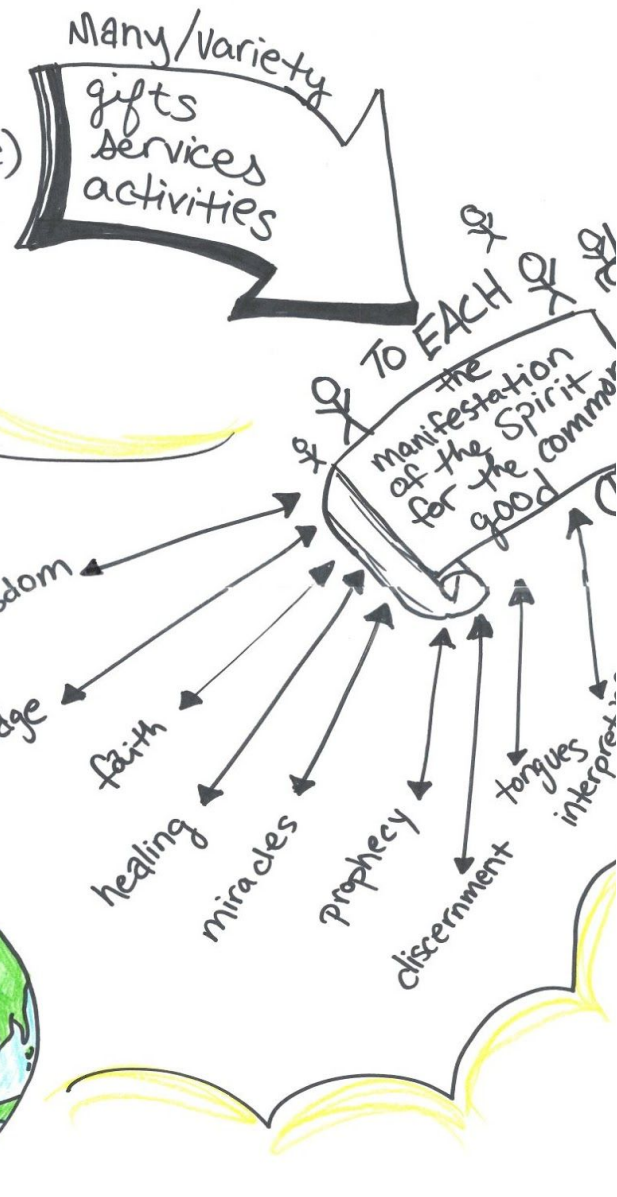
*Especially if this is your first Sunday, Welcome!*
