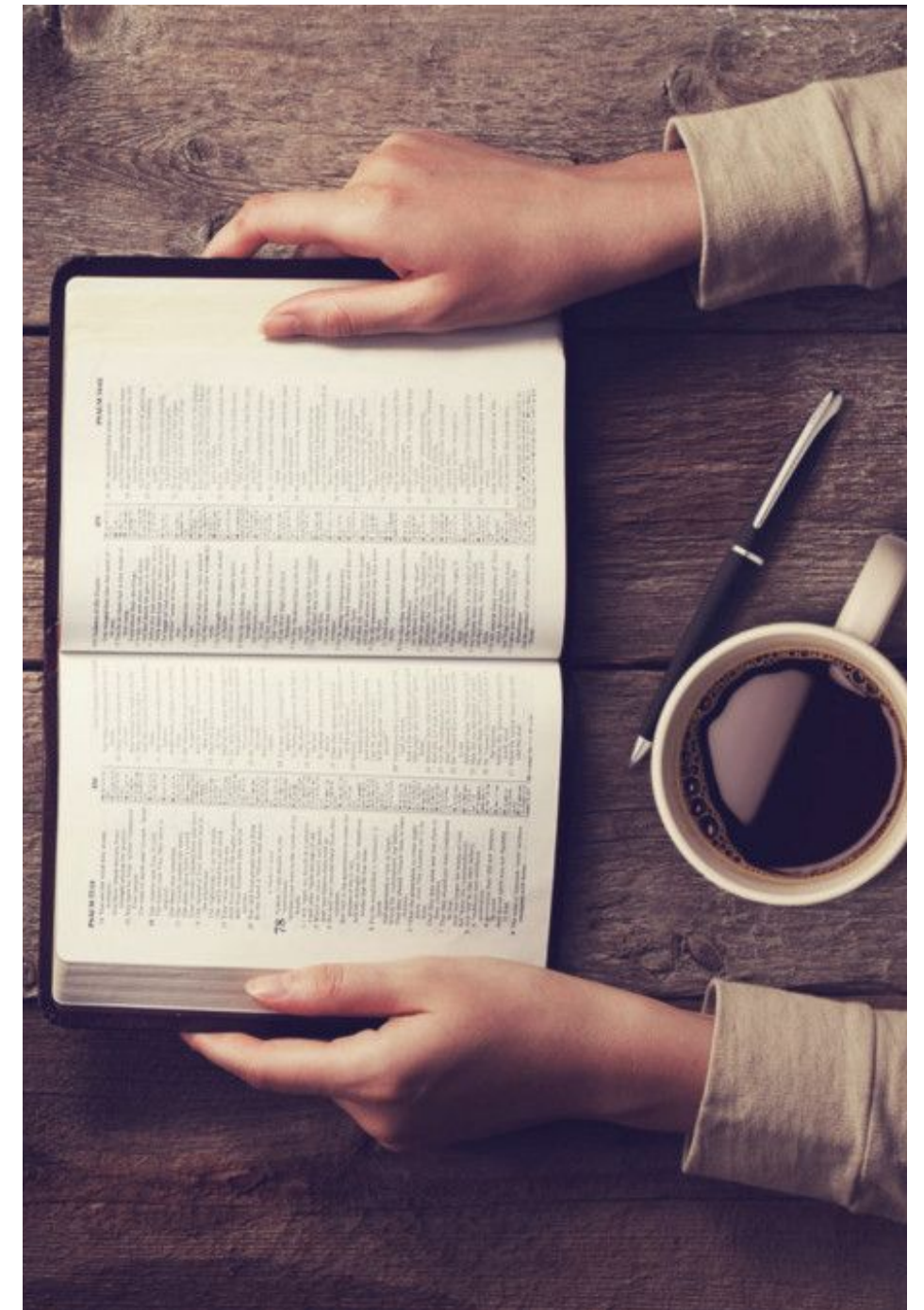
One Thing Remains - Jesus Culture
