And this gathered community makes space for our individual faith to flourish. ...Like the mural above: close up, it's individual brushstrokes (each one is needed), but step back and you see a whole, powerful and vibrant story.

The Trustees' renovation work continues. Work has started on the Education building with the installation of seven new a/c units




















As finance committee prays and prepares for our 2024 ministries, we invite you to be part of the planning process.





